An photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—that includes one of the following rivers, taken in the county that is either the headwaters of that river or where that river first enters Pennsylvania: Allegheny, Delaware, French Creek, Monongahela, Schuylkill, or Susquehanna.
- 4. An photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—in front of a historic theater that opened prior to 1940. The theater doesn’t need to be open to the public at this time.
- 5. A label** from a bottle of a Pennsylvania-produced soft drink or beer, the label must indicate where the product was made or indicate that it was bottled under the authority of a Pennsylvania-based company. Photocopies are not acceptable.
- 6. An photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—with a Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Society historical marker regarding an event or occurrence prior to 1800.
- 7. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—next to a Pennsylvania elected official on either the local, county or state level.

- 10. A letter** addressed to you from your school district’s superintendent of schools on the district’s letterhead. Entrants from out-of-state can obtain a letter from a superintendent from any Pennsylvania school district.
- 11. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—who appears with a living representative of our state’s official dog breed.
- 12. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—with a local band/symphony playing at a public outdoor location (park, bandstand, gazebo, etc.). Note that concerts by a touring artist is not eligible.
- 13. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—with a high water mark plaque or other designation related to one of three historic floods: 1889 (Johnstown), 1936 (St. Patrick’s Day Flood) or 1972 (Hurricane Agnes).

Using a Priority Mail Flat Rate envelope might make it easier to send your entry, but that's not required. **Postmark entry deadline is September 22, 2023.**

3. Every entrant who submits a complete entry will receive a certificate and will be entered in a drawing for one of 15 *Pennsylvania Magazine* T-shirts. Indicate desired size on entry form.
4. All entrants, by action of entry, give consent to use of their names and hometowns and images from their entries to be used in a future issue of the magazine and/or on the magazine's website in materials related to the Super Summer Scavenger Hunt.
5. The three top place winners, determined by their entry's geographic distribution in the state (50%) completeness (30%) and quality of the entries (20%). These first-, second- and third-place winners will receive cash prizes to be announced in the July/August issue.
6. Entries must be postmarked by September 22, 2023.
7. The judge's decision is final.
8. If you win one of the top three place prizes, you will be notified by phone and/or mail in October 2023. Your name and hometown will appear as a winner in the January/February 2024 issue.
9. Photos of entrants' submitted entries may appear in the January/February 2024 issue as art accompanying the announcement of the winners in the contest.
10. If you'd like your entry form returned, enclose sufficient postage for its return.

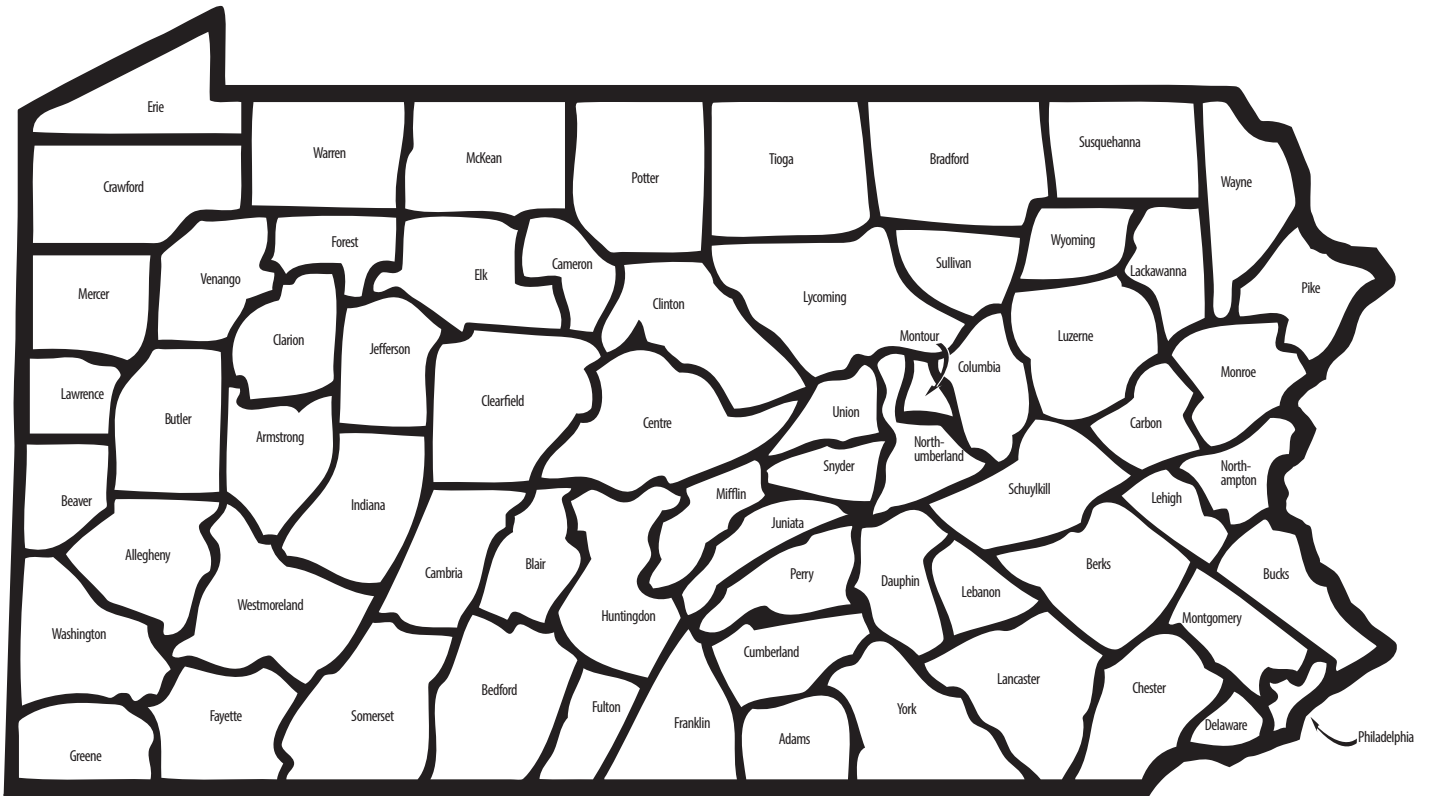
