- 3. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—that includes a county courthouse that is either built primarily of stone, or is faced with stone. It can be a former courthouse if it is still standing.
- 4. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—in front of a designated marker/banner/flag/etc. seen along one of three National Historic Trails (not Heritage) that cross our state. (See NPS.gov)
- 5. A box top/packaging** from a prepared breakfast cereal or pasta that is manufactured in Pennsylvania. Specify the manufacturer and the location of production. Photocopies are not acceptable.
- 6. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—with a hot air balloon either aloft or being inflated on the ground. The balloon should be easily identified in the photo. Identify the location where the photo was taken, and the operator of the balloon if known/festival if applicable.

- 11. A cover of a program** (or similar) from a Pennsylvania-based minor league baseball or soccer team. Must be dated 2024. Photocopies are not acceptable.
- 12. A photo** of someone—who also appears in item number one’s photo—shown at an outdoor—regularly held—community farmers market with a food vendor (produce, cheese, meat, etc) and stand in the background.

Using a Priority Mail Flat Rate envelope might make it easier to send your entry, but that's not required. **Postmark entry deadline is September 22, 2024.**

## 2024 Super Summer Scavenger Hunt Contest Rules

1. To be eligible, answers must be indicated on the contest entry form or a photocopy of the entry form and submitted by U.S. postal mail.
2. Only one entry per household / mailing address will be accepted.
3. Every entrant who submits a complete entry will receive a certificate and will be entered in a drawing for one of 15 *Pennsylvania Magazine* T-shirts. Indicate desired size on entry form.
4. All entrants, by action of entry, give consent to use of their names and hometowns and images from their entries in a future issue of the magazine and/or on the magazine's website in materials related to the Super Summer Scavenger Hunt. All published photographs will be attributed to the entrant/photographer
5. Three top place winners will be determined by their entry's geographic distribution in the state (40%) completeness (40%) and quality of the entries (20%). These first-, second- and third-place winners will receive cash prizes of \$250 (1st), \$150 (2nd) and \$75 (3rd).
6. Entries must be postmarked by September 22, 2024.
7. The judge's decision is final.
8. If you win one of the top three place prizes, you will be notified by phone and/or mail in November 2024. Your name and hometown will appear as a winner in the January/February 2025 issue.
9. Photos of entrants' submitted entries may appear in the January/February 2025 issue as art accompanying the announcement of the winners in the contest.
10. If you'd like your entry form returned, enclose sufficient postage for its return.

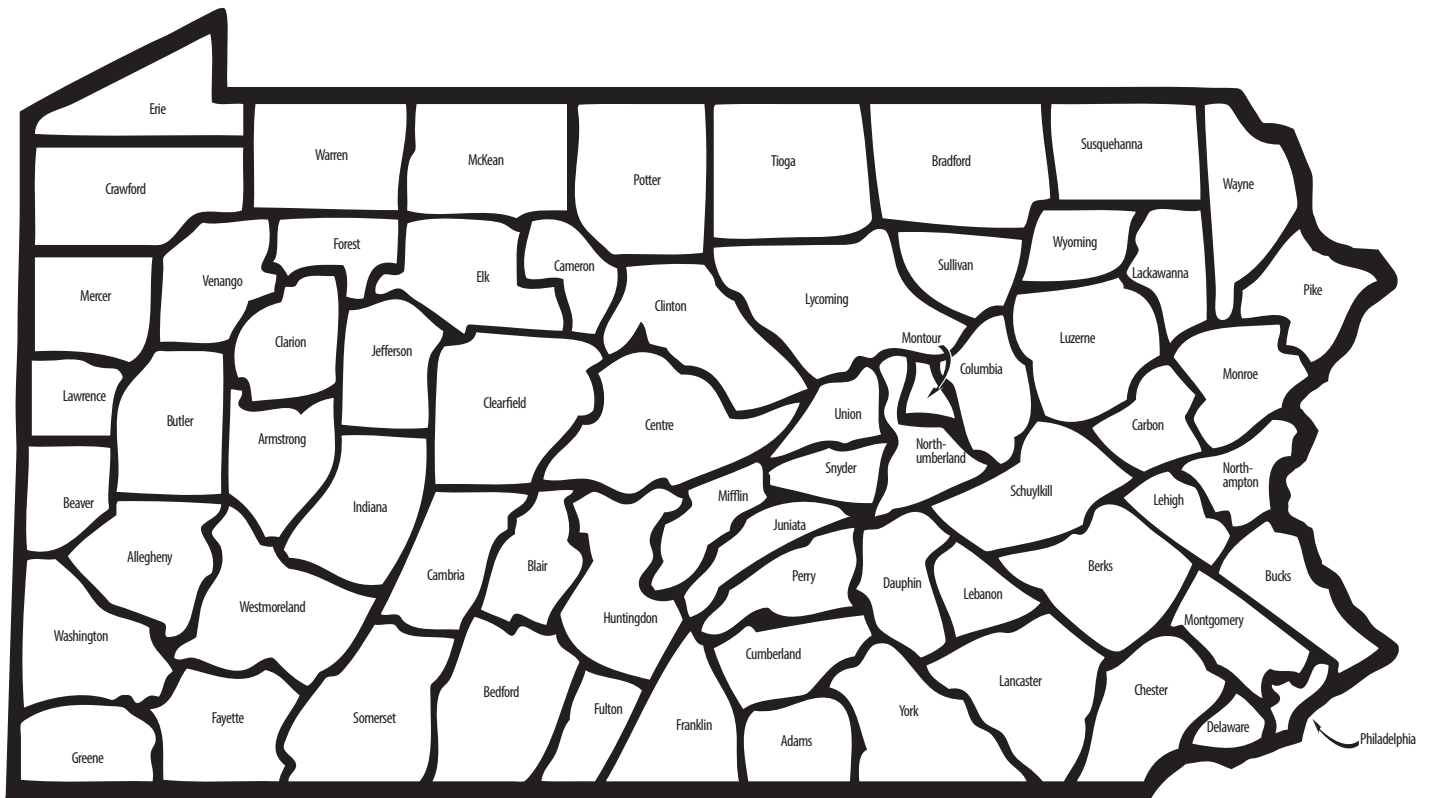
